With a vote in the affirmative, the first reading by the title of Ordinance 2023-13 was approved. Ordinance 2023-13 authorizes funding for repairs and rehabilitation work to municipal buildings.

Councilman Russell announced that the lifeguard complement is still full. Within a week, some of the personnel will start to go back to school. The lifeguard captain said the water has been cleaner and warmer this season. The Gator program is running well. The pickleball bid will be on September 7, 2023. And the lifeguards now have a new drone. It has all kinds of capabilities. It is suitable for spotting sharks, lost children, and rip currents. It is an improvement to the lifeguard program.

Council President Wm. Hodgson provided the statistical report for the police department. The property stolen involves some stolen vehicles. People leave their keys in their cars. Please ensure your doors are locked, and no valuables are in plain sight. It is especially easy to feel safe on LBI. The fireworks were on July 3<sup>rd</sup>. Thanks to all those who helped, especially the fire department and the donors who made it possible. Trunk or treat is coming fast; the date is set for October 28<sup>th</sup>, and the rain date is October 29<sup>th</sup>.

Councilwoman Siciliano reported that the Department of Public Works continues to work on potholes. ADA parking spots are being stenciled around town. The N. 8<sup>th</sup> Street project is still set for September. The administrative staff organized a Q&A for the N. 8<sup>th</sup> residents or anyone who would like to attend. The administrative staff is always available for questions.

Mayor F. Hodgson mentioned the large sum of money the County allocated for stormwater management. The mayor contacted the County Commissioner, and the Borough will get a share.

Councilwoman Siciliano provided the sanitation report for Councilman McMenamin. She moved Resolutions 2023-130. Councilman Hartney seconded the motion. With a vote in the affirmative, Resolution 2023-130 was approved, as attached. Councilwoman Siciliano also moved Resolution 2023-134. Councilman Russell seconded the motion. Councilman Hartney said that the Tuesday morning Bay Program continues to succeed. He announced the beach badge sales report. Councilman Hartney moved Resolution 2023-131. Councilman Russell seconded the motion. With a vote in the affirmative, Resolution 2023-131 was approved, as attached.

Councilman Little announced that July was a busy month in water & sewer, as usual, and

provided the statistical report for July. There were no emergencies last month. On N. 9<sup>th</sup> Street, an iron pump went out and was replaced. It demonstrated our cooperation in public works and the water department. The crew got a tremendous job done in one day. It was about 110 degrees in the middle of the street. We also replaced a small pump in Well 6. On Well 7, we removed the old valve and installed a new one. Councilman Little thanked Mayor F. Hodgson for his help with the significant pump repair for Well 7.
