Mayor F. Hodgson provided the chief financial and court reports for September 2023 Councilman McMenamin provided the sanitary analysis and recycling report for October.

Councilman Russell congratulated the mayor and the three council persons for winning their election. The Borough is accomplishing a lot; the South Water Tower is just about completed, the pickleball contract has been awarded, the lifeguards are hibernating for the winter, the mold inspection was an A plus. The playgrounds are being winterized, the roof contract has been signed and the holiday lights have been installed.

Council President Wm. Hodgson gave the statistical report for the Police Department. The value of the stolen property was two thefts, only a little to report until the investigation is over. The 18-mile run came through town. On the 28^{th,} we had the trunk or treat. Anyone in town would notice a winding serpentine line around the blocks. The Chief reported this was the biggest one ever, with 950 kids. He thanked all the participants.

Councilwoman Siciliano reported that streets and roads are busy. The current work project on N. 8th Street is progressing on schedule. The milling and paving will be completed by Thanksgiving. The administrative staff and Borough Engineer will keep the fire company apprised. As per the Borough engineer, the N 15th Street project is completed. We are looking to bond the next project in January for N. 1st, N. 2^{nd,} and N. 3rd Streets to be completed in the spring. She thanked the administrative staff for their hard work in completing road projects, about two per year- we used to complete one more every year. The Borough was awarded \$370,645 for the 2023 NJDOT grant. The application was for N. 10th, N. 13th and N. 15th Streets. We hope the project will be done in the fall of next year. She congratulated the election winners.

Councilman Hartney congratulated the election winners. While Mr. Russel has hibernated the lifeguards, the badge department is working hard to fund them. We have sold 408 badges. We have 792 badges left to sell. Get them quickly before they sell out. We spent the afternoon touring the Borough with the NJ Climate Resiliency Committee. We are in conversation and planning for the projects to come forward.

Councilman Little congratulated the election winners and thanked everyone for their support. We thank the police department, administrative staff, and the Department of Public Works. The mayor has been serving the people of Surf City for fifty-eight years. The mayor is one of the longest-serving officials in the state. We are blessed to have that continuity and will work to keep it. The Water and Sewer departments were quiet this month. Some of the monthly reports reflect that Public Works assisted with patching. As everyone can see, we are progressing significantly on the water tower. On Saturday, the eleventh day, the eleventh month, and the eleventh day is Armistice Day. Surf City has quite a few veterans, as are some on the council, activate children. The US sent fighter jets to Syria; we thank our veterans. Councilman Russell moved to approve paying the bills. Councilwoman Russell seconded the motion. With a vote in the affirmative, the bills were approved. Roll call reflected the following votes in approval: Mr. Hartney, Mr. Wm.
