TRASH AND RECYCLING CONTAINERS MAY NOT HAVE PREATTACHED LIDS, EXCEED 50 LBS, OR BE LARGER THAN 32 GALLONS IN SIZE.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

WHAT SIZE TRASH CAN MAY I HAVE? ARE THERE ANY RESTRICTIONS?

Trash cans cannot exceed 32 gallons & 50 lbs. Containers must be secured with a watertight lid that is not fastened to the container. **ALL TRASH MUST BE IN A CONTAINER. TRASH MUST BE ON THE CURB LINE FOR PICK UP. RESIDENTS ARE RESPONSIBLE TO RETURN CANS TO ENCLOSURES/PROPERTY AFTER PICK UP.**

WHEN CAN I PUT MY BULK TRASH OUT?

Bulk trash is picked up each week EXCEPT holiday weeks—place items out at the curb on Tuesday night. The sanitation crew may take a few days to pick up the whole town. The doors must be removed from all refrigerators and freezers.

WHAT CAN I DO WITH BRUSH, CLIPPINGS, AND LEAVES?

Brush must be bundled and tied in 4-foot lengths or less, weighing no more than 40 lbs. with limbs. Limbs cannot be more than 3.5 inches in diameter. Please put it at the curb for the following available collection. Large biodegradable leaf bags are on sale in the Borough Clerk's Office for \$.50 each. Bags must be tied or secured for pick up.

WHAT ABOUT CONSTRUCTION DEBRIS?

Wood/lumber may not be longer than 4 feet and bundled no more than 12 inches. All nails must be removed. Where a BUILDING PERMIT is required, the homeowner and the contractor are responsible for disposal.

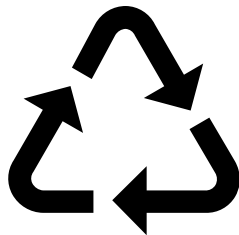
WILL MY CARPET BE PICKED UP?

Homeowners replacing the carpet must cut & tie the carpet into 4-foot bundles not weighing more than 40 lbs. Please put it on the curb for collection starting Wednesday morning on Tuesday night.

HAZARDOUS MATERIALS DISPOSAL

Please contact the Southern Ocean County Recycling Center for information about properly disposing of Hazardous Materials (at 69)978-0913. Hours of operation are Monday through Saturday, 7:30 am to 3 pm. Saturdays are for Ocean County Residents only.

HOUSEHOLD TRASH SHALL NOT BE DISPOSED OF IN OR AROUND MUNICIPAL LITTER CANS. FINES UP TO \$2,500.00 AND PENALTIES UP \$10,000.00 COURT APPEARANCE REQUIRED. AREAS MAY BE MONITORED.
