While you're enjoying this lovely island, please check out these tips for recycling during your stay:

- Clean and dry materials only
- Don't bag materials
- Rechargeable batteries via drop-off only, they are a fire hazard in your bin!
- Alkaline batteries can go in regular garbage

01 GLASS

Bottles and jars, must be clean and dry. Silverware, mirrors, and light bulbs are not acceptable.

03 METAL CANS

Aluminum & Steel, food containers, and Aluminum Foil – must be clean and dry.

05 Plastic

Only clean – food contaminated containers are not acceptable. Please keep lids and caps on. #1, #2 and #5 are recyclable - #s 3, 4, 6 and 7 are not accepted. Plastic utensils, plates, and cups are also not accepted, so please reconsider using single-use plastics!

02 Cardboard

Please flatten the boxes and do not tie. Remove the greasy part of pizza boxes.

04 PAPER

Not shredded, no glitter or foil. Mixed material papers, like wax coated containers, are not acceptable.
