Governing Body Meeting Minutes

Mayor F. Hodgson called the meeting to order, reading the following statement. In compliance with the Open Public Meetings Act of the State of New Jersey, adequate notice of this meeting of the Borough Council has been provided to three newspapers and published in the Asbury Park Press on January 11, 2024.

The roll call reflected the following members present: Councilman Joseph DeBenedetto, Councilman Peter M. Hartney, Council President William D. Hodgson, Councilwoman Jaqueline L. Siciliano, and Mayor Francis R. Hodgson. Councilman Gerry P. Little and Councilman John D. McMenamin were absent.

Chief Financial Officer Michael Gross, Police Chief Jack Casella and Superintendent Art Yahn were also in attendance.

All present joined Mayor F. Hodgson in a salute to the Flag.

Councilman DeBenedetto moved to approve the September 11, 2024, regular meeting minutes. Council President Wm. Hodgson seconded the motion. With a vote in the affirmative, the minutes were approved.

The roll call reflected the following votes for approval: Mr. DeBenedetto, Mr. Hartney, Mr. Wm. Hodgson, and Mrs. Siciliano. Nays: none. Abstentions: none. Mr. Little and Mr. McMenamin were absent.

Resolutions 2024-137 through 2024-143 were considered and approved, as attached.

Mayor F. Hodgson read the August 2024 Chief Financial Officer and Municipal Court reports.

Councilman DeBenedetto conducted an extensive walkthrough of all the Borough properties with the Borough Superintendent. The siding has been repaired on the N. 13th Street garage after storm damage. We are currently getting bids for the windows. The pickleball committee has met for the final time this year; we had a successful year. The Lifeguard Captain is cleaning up and preparing everything for 2025.

Council President Wm. Hodgson provided the police department statistical report for September 2024. The SCPD runs the CARE program. They will call any disabled resident each day for a wellness check. The Borough also provides winter and vacation home checks. You can register by visiting the SCPD website, complete and submit the forms. The annual Trunk or Treat is October 26th. Council President Wm. Hodgson moved Resolutions 2024-144 and 2024-146, which were approved, as attached.

Councilwoman Siciliano provided the water/sewer, and public works streets & roads report reports. She also moved Resolution 2024-145, which was approved, as attached. The SFY 2023 NJDOT project for N. 1st, N. 2nd, and N. 3rd Streets bid will be October 31st. We will have a meeting with the property owners to review the project and scope of work. The engineer is

working with the County to get a price for the S. 1st Street bulkhead. Councilwoman Siciliano reminded everyone that hydrant flushing is next week.

Councilman Hartney mentioned that we are already looking forward to next year. The Holiday Badge Sale began on October 1st. He has been in discussions with the ACOE, Congressman Van Drew's office and Senator Booker to advocate for Surf City so they amend the budget to include Surf City. On October 18th, the County will deliver the dune grass plantings.

The Surf City Taxpayers Association has requested to host a community event on Saturday, June 21, 2025, from 4:00 pm and 7:00 pm. They are requesting trash containers, vehicle access to the field, to serve food and have one live band. Chuck Edwards spoke about the event. The request was approved on the basis that out-of-town vendors would not be present and that a sketch of the booths be submitted prior to the event. Councilman Hartney moved to approve the request. Council President Wm. Hodgson seconded the motion. With a vote in the affirmative the request was approved. The roll call reflected the following votes for approval: Mr. DeBenedetto, Mr. Hartney, Mr. Wm. Hodgson, and Mrs. Siciliano. Nays: none. Abstentions: none. Mr. Little and Mr. McMenamin were absent.

WHEREAS, The Borough of Surf City (hereinafter "Borough") and the State of New Jersey (hereinafter "State") are participating with the United States Army Corp of Engineers (hereinafter "ACOE") to construct the Barnegat Inlet to Little Egg Inlet Storm Drainage Reduction project (hereinafter "Project"); and

WHEREAS, construction of the project includes periodic renourishment which may be performed solely by the Borough and the State or in conjunction with the ACOE; and

WHEREAS, as a requirement of the Project, the Borough and the State must obtain a perpetual storm damage reduction easement on portions of properties along the beachfront which includes Block 50, Lot 4 (hereinafter "Property"); and

WHEREAS, the property is owned by Matthew Eitner and Kate Eitner and is known and designed as Block 50, Lot 4 as shown on the official tax map of the Borough of Surf City commonly known as 1817 North Ocean Avenue, Surf City, New Jersey; and

WHEREAS, the original Grantors, William H. and Joann Mulcahy, at the request of the Borough, entered into an Easement Agreement between itself as Grantor and the Borough and New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection as Grantees entitled Deed of Dedication and Perpetual Storm Damage Reduction Easement on July 3, 2006 and recorded on July 19, 2006 in the Ocean County Clerk's Office; and

WHEREAS, the original easement was granted with existing structures, including a residential home, located within the grant of easement; and
