Governing Body Meeting Minutes

Mayor F. Hodgson called the meeting to order, reading the following statement. In compliance with the Open Public Meetings Act of the State of New Jersey, adequate notice of this meeting of the Borough Council has been provided to three newspapers and published in the Asbury Park Press on January 11, 2024.

The roll call reflected the following members present: Councilman Joseph DeBenedetto, Councilman Peter M. Hartney, Council President William D. Hodgson, Councilman Gerry P. Little, Councilwoman Jaqueline L. Siciliano, and Mayor Francis R. Hodgson. Councilman John D. McMenamin was absent.

Police Chief Jack Casella and Acting Superintendent Leonard Wilson were also in attendance.

All present joined Mayor F. Hodgson in a salute to the Flag.

Councilman Hartney moved to approve the August 14, 2024, regular and executive session minutes. Council President Wm. Hodgson seconded the motion. With a vote in the affirmative, the minutes were approved.

The roll call reflected the following votes for approval: Mr. DeBenedetto, Mr. Wm. Hodgson, Mr. Little, and Mrs. Siciliano. Nays: none. Abstentions: none. Mr. McMenamin was absent.

Resolutions 2024-131-133 were considered and approved, as attached.

Mayor F. Hodgson read the July 2024 Chief Financial Officer and Municipal Court reports.

Councilman DeBenedetto reported no significant injuries on the beaches for the 2024 season. The colder water temperatures accounted for fewer rescues. Six of the LIT participants will become lifeguards next year. The Gator program received a lot of great comments. We are waiting for the truck to be built for the beach patrol. Pickleball is up and running. A tour of the Borough facilities was completed, and recommendations have been given to the Borough Clerk. We have many repairs to focus on, and window quotes have been solicited. He then moved Resolution 2024-135, which was approved, as attached.

Council President Wm. Hodgson provided the police department with the statistical report for August 2024. A high-value vehicle was stolen. Please remember to remove your key fobs from your cars. On August 6th, the Police Department attended the National Night Out event at Bayview Park in Long Beach Township. Trunk or Treat will be hosted on October 26th.

Councilwoman Siciliano provided the August 2024 DPW streets and roads work order report. She thanked them for cleaning all the drains in the Borough. We met with the NJDOT to discuss the upcoming road project. They have promised notices. A handout with all of the information released from the NJDOT is available. The S. 1st Street bulkhead replacement will hopefully be underway in October. The next road project for 1st, 2nd, and 3rd is in State review. A questionand-answer session will be held for those residents. Councilwoman Siciliano moved Resolutions

204-136 & 2024-137, which were approved, as attached. Before closing her report, Councilwoman Siciliano took a moment to remember 9/11.

Councilman Hartney announced that 503 individuals participated in each Barnegat Bay Hands-on Learning program session with the Alliance for a Living Ocean. Attendance can be attributed to the announcement on the sign board outside of Borough Hall most of the summer. He attended a pre-construction meeting in Beach Haven for the LBI beach replenishment. Surf City was scheduled as an option. The work begins soon, and he will continue to advocate for Surf City all winter. A few badge checkers were awarded a certificate for selling over 1,000 beach badges this season: Aiden Grindley, Tyler Leidemer, Maya Faulds, and Wynter Hall.

Councilman Little reported on the water and sewer work orders for August 2024; there were 48 mark outs. Last month, a lightning strike occurred at the N. 14th Street water plant. The crew patched several water ditches. The annual fall hydrant flushing is scheduled for the week of October 15th. Please run your faucets until the water runs clear. Councilman Little also remembered 9/11, thanking Councilman Hartney for his words of comfort at the County ceremony. We lost at least 21 Ocean County residents. With the war on terror, we have lost 13 soldiers from Ocean County.

Kara King has requested a bench on N. 5th and the Ocean for her father. The request was approved on a motion by Council President Wm. Hodgson. Councilman Hartney seconded the motion. The roll call reflected the following votes for approval: Mr. DeBenedetto, Mr. Hartney, Mr. Wm. Hodgson, Mr. Little, and Mrs. Siciliano. Nays: none. Abstentions: none. Absent: Mr. McMenamin.

Mike Tomko has requested to host a 5K run on November 30, 2024. The request was approved on a motion by Councilman Hartney. Councilwoman Siciliano seconded the motion. The roll call reflected the following votes for approval: Mr. DeBenedetto, Mr. Hartney, Mr. Wm. Hodgson, Mr. Little, and Mrs. Siciliano. Nays: none. Abstentions: none. Absent: Mr. McMenamin.

Councilman Hartney moved to approve paying the bills. Councilman DeBenedetto seconded the motion. With a vote in the affirmative of the members present, bills were approved to be paid.
