Governing Body Meeting Minutes

Mayor F. Hodgson called the meeting to order, reading the following statement. In compliance with the Open Public Meetings Act of the State of New Jersey, adequate notice of this meeting of the Borough Council has been provided to three newspapers and published in the Beach Haven Times on January 9, 2025.

The roll call reflected the following members present: Councilman Joe DeBenedetto, Councilman Peter M. Hartney, Councilman William D. Hodgson, Councilman Lee Lieber, Councilman Gerry P. Little, Councilwoman Jacqueline L. Siciliano, and Mayor Francis R. Hodgson.

Borough Superintendent Art Yahn, Chief Jack Casella, and CFO Michael Gross attended.

All present joined Mayor F. Hodgson in a salute to the Flag.

Councilwoman Siciliano moved to approve the minutes of the July 9, 2025, meeting. Councilman Hartney seconded the motion. With a vote in the affirmative, the minutes were approved.

The roll call reflected the following votes for approval: Mr. DeBenedetto, Mr. Hartney, Mr. Wm. Hodgson, Mr. Lieber, Mr. Little, and Mrs. Siciliano.

Councilman Hartney moved to approve the introduction and first reading by title only of Ordinance 2025-06. Council President Wm. Hodgson seconded the motion. With a vote in the affirmative, the introduction of Ordinance 2025-06 was approved. The roll call reflected the following votes for approval: Mr. DeBenedetto, Mr. Hartney, Mr. Wm. Council President Wm. Hodgson moved to approve the introduction and first reading by title only of Ordinance 2025-07. Councilman Hartney seconded the motion. With a vote in the affirmative, the introduction of Ordinance 2025-07 was approved. The roll call reflected the following votes for approval: Mr. DeBenedetto, Mr. Hartney, Mr. Wm. Hodgson, Mr. Lieber, Mr. Little, and Mrs. Siciliano. Ordinance 2025-07 allows nonprofit organizations to have amplified sound and/or music for special events by resolution of the Governing Body.

Resolutions 2025-126 to 2025-137 were approved, as attached.

Mayor F. Hodgson read the June 2025 Municipal Court and CFO reports.

Councilman Lieber presented the July 2025 police department statistical report.

Councilman DeBenedetto thanked Art and the crew for installing the basketball systems. The irrigation system at Veterans' Park is being repaired. The tentative installation date for the pavilion is set for October. The windows were awarded for this meeting; hopefully, they will be completed in September. After Atlantic City Electric assesses the new LED lights, we will be ordering some shields. We are still experiencing issues with dogs in the recreation areas. The "no dogs" signs have been installed. He reviewed the beach patrol report, reminding surfers to be mindful of the swimming areas.

Council President Wm. Hodgson read the sanitary landfill analysis and recycling report. We've hired a code enforcer to help manage the dogs in our parks. He recognized the sanitation department for their hard work collecting the trash during the recent heat wave.

Councilwoman Siciliano read the Streets & Roads DPW report for July 2025. She reported on the pre-con meeting held for the following NJDOT grant project on N. 10th, N. 13th, and N. 15th road reconstruction projects. The work will start in October, settle over the winter, with paving to take place in the spring. On August 12th, we hosted a meeting with the residents to discuss the upcoming projects and answer any of their questions. The bulkhead work for N. 12th and N. 13th Streets will begin around August 18th. She will be attending a meeting on August 26th with Congressman Van Drew to discuss budgeting concerns for beach replenishment.

Councilman Hartney reported the beach badge sales. One of the badge checkers has reached 1,000 badges sold. The Tuesday morning Bay program has been running for fifteen years. Last week, about 30-40 people attended. The seining produced different types of seagrasses.

Councilman Little provided the July 2025 water and sewer report. The crew is working to survey the water system. We experienced issues with the routers and communication system, which were subsequently repaired. The Well 6 pump was pulled for repair/replacement, and a module was also repaired during this process.

Melissa Simon requested that a bench be placed to honor Susan Nestoros for her 70th Birthday. Council President Wm. Hodgson moved to approve the request. Councilman Hartney seconded the motion. With a vote in the affirmative, the request was approved. The roll call reflected the following votes in favor of approval: Mr. DeBenedetto, Mr. Hartney, Mr. Wm. Hodgson, Mr. Lieber, Mr. Little, and Mrs. Siciliano. There were no abstentions.

Carol Williamson and Pat Warford requested a memorial bench for their mother, Peg Robinson. Councilman DeBenedetto moved to approve the request. Councilwoman Siciliano seconded the motion. With a vote in the affirmative, the request was approved. The roll call reflected the following votes in favor of approval: Mr. DeBenedetto, Mr. Hartney, Mr. Wm. Hodgson, Mr. Lieber, Mr. Little, and Mrs. Siciliano. There were no abstentions.

Marianne Murray requested a memorial bench for her parents, Tom and Lorraine Russo. Councilman Hartney moved to approve the request. Councilman Lieber seconded the motion. With a vote in the affirmative, the request was approved. The roll call reflected the following votes in favor of approval: Mr. DeBenedetto, Mr. Hartney, Mr. Wm. Hodgson, Mr. Lieber, Mr. Little, and Mrs. Siciliano. There were no abstentions.

Cathy Moeller requested permission for a charity bike ride to come through Surf City. This requires the Borough to endorse an Ocean County parade permit. Councilwoman Siciliano moved to approve the request for a permit endorsement with the submission of a certificate of liability and an executed hold harmless agreement. Council President Wm. Hodgson seconded the request. With a vote in the affirmative, the request was approved. The roll call reflected the following votes in favor of approval: Mr. DeBenedetto, Mr. Hartney, Mr. Wm. Hodgson, Mr. Lieber, Mr. Little, and Mrs. Siciliano. There were no abstentions.

Councilman Hartney moved to pay the bills. Councilwoman Siciliano seconded the motion. The bills were approved for payment. The call reflected the following votes for approval: Mr. DeBenedetto, Mr. Hartney, Mr. Wm. Hodgson, Mr. Lieber, Mr. Little, and Mrs. Siciliano. There were no abstentions.

Mayor F. Hodgson called for any comments from the public.

Paul Russo requested that the mats remain on the beach until at least October 12th.

Councilmembers explained that the Borough does not have the manpower to remove the mats that late in the season. Hurricane season poses a risk to the mats with high tides. The N. 12th Street mat will remain until the first week of October.

Tony Pace inquired about water usage.

Ron Fiore commented that Surf City's fees for pickleball are the lowest on LBI.

Jim Hines commented on the badge checking process.

Vinnie DiSalvio raised concerns about bicycles on the sidewalks.

Councilman Hartney moved to adjourn the meeting. Councilwoman Siciliano seconded the motion. With a vote in the affirmative, the meeting was adjourned. The roll call reflected the following votes for approval: Mr. DeBenedetto, Mr. Hartney, Mr. Wm. Hodgson, Mr. Lieber, Mr. Little, & Mrs. Siciliano. There were no nays or abstentions.

3. That a certified copy of this Resolution shall be forwarded to Jenna Letts, the Borough Administrator, and the Chief Financial Officer of the Borough.




