

ORDINANCE 2025-07

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING AN ORDINANCE ENTITLED "REVISED GENERAL ORDINANCES OF THE BOROUGH OF SURF CITY, COUNTY OF OCEAN, STATE OF NEW JERSEY, 2000," AS THE SAME IN CHAPTER 4, PERTAINS TO "POLICE REGULATIONS."

The Mayor and Borough Council of the Borough of Surf City do ordain:

SECTION I

Chapter 4 Section 3.5 titled "Exceptions" is hereby added, as follows.

The Governing Body may permit live performances and/or amplified sound for bona fide non-profit organizations hosting special events, with terms and conditions set by resolution.

SECTION II

All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

SECTION III

If any word, phrase, clause, section, or provision of this ordinance shall be found by any Court of competent jurisdiction to be unenforceable, illegal, or unconstitutional. If such words, phrases, clauses, sections, or provisions shall be severable from the balance of the ordinance, the remainder shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION IV

According to law, this ordinance shall take effect immediately after final adoption.
