Resolution 2025-139 awards the bid for the 2025 American Rescue Plan Drainage and Flood Improvement Project for the 200 Block of N. 4<sup>th</sup> Street and the 300 Blocks of S. 3<sup>rd</sup>, S. 2<sup>nd</sup>, Bay Terrace, S. 1<sup>st</sup>, N. 2<sup>nd</sup>, N. 4<sup>th</sup>, N. 9<sup>th</sup>, N. 11<sup>th</sup>, and N. 12<sup>th</sup> Streets. The Borough Clerk has received the following bids.

- Earle Asphalt Co. for \$1,339,413.13.
- Arawak Paving Co., Inc. for \$1,243,000.00.

The Borough Engineer and Borough Attorney have reviewed the bids and recommend awarding the contract to Arawak Paving Co., Inc. for \$1,243,000.00.
