

## NOTICE TO BIDDERS

Public notice is hereby given that separate sealed bids will be received and opened by the Borough of Surf City at the Borough Hall, 813 Long Beach Boulevard, Surf City, NJ at 11:00 AM on February 18, 2026 for the following project:

**2025 DRAINAGE AND FLOOD IMPROVEMENT PROJECT- PHASE 2 – S. 2ND ST., DREXEL AVENUE, N. 5<sup>TH</sup> ST., N. 23RD ST., SUNSET AVENUE, N 24TH ST., BAY VISTA DRIVE AND SCHNEIDER LANE, BOROUGH OF SURF CITY:** The purpose of this project is to provide drainage and flood improvements including the mill and overlay of six (6) roadways and reconstruction of two (2) roadways in the Borough of Surf City. Work shall include approximately 2,695 square yards pavement removal, 2,695 square yards dense grade aggregate, 12,555 square yards milling, 3,658 tons hot mix asphalt, 102 linear feet drainage pipe, three (3) drainage structures, 914 linear feet concrete curb, 383 square yards driveway restoration, pavement striping, turf repair and all other necessary work to complete the project, as specified.

**A Buy America Compliance Plan is required to confirm that the material meets the Buy America requirements and the Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act (“IIJA”), Pub. L. No. 117-58, which includes the Build America, Buy America Act (“the Act”). Pub. L. No. 117-58, §§ 70901-52 as specified in 106.03. See Special Provisions Section 106.**

The Contract Specification Documents may be obtained at the office of the Borough Engineer, Owen, Little & Associates, Inc., 443 Atlantic City Boulevard, Beachwood, NJ, 08722, during normal business hours (8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.) on or after February 4, 2026 upon payment of \$50.00 per set. **CHECKS MUST BE MADE PAYABLE TO BOROUGH OF SURF CITY.** If a FED EX or UPS Account is not available and it must be mailed, an additional payment of \$30.00 will be required. (*check made payable to Owen, Little & Associates*). **Official documents must be purchased from Owen, Little & Associates for Bid Submission. No downloaded documents will be accepted, as we cannot guarantee accuracy.**

A BID BOND drawn to the order of the Borough of Surf City in an amount equal to ten (10%) percent of the amount of the Bid, but no more than \$20,000.00, must be submitted with the proposal as BID SECURITY, pursuant to Local Public Contract Law (LPC) 40A:11-21.

Bids may be submitted by mail or in person at any time prior to the time for receiving and opening the same. Bidders are required to comply with the requirements of N.J.S.A. 10:5-31 et seq. and N.J.A.C. 17:27.

The Borough of Surf City reserves the right to waive any informalities and to reject any and all bids.
